## DES KILLICK FOUNDATION STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP

Des Killick was born in 1937 in the North of England. During his life he travelled widely and lived abroad extensively, mainly Canada before settling in Perth, WA to run a successful commercial business.

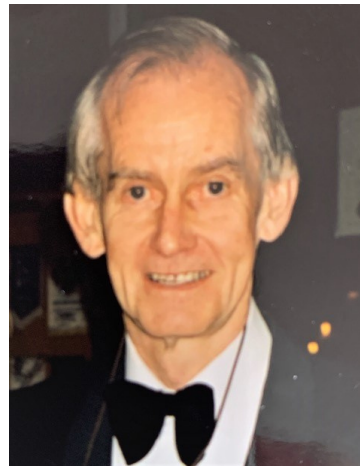
In Perth, Des had several varied interests, however was particularly involved in two local Clubs where he was always keen to accept responsible positions. He joined the Rotary Club of Como in 1986 and was Club President in 1992-93. Des was highly involved in Rotary whilst living in Canada and was President of his local Club. Therefore, Des was a highly experienced and dedicated Rotarian, who upheld and lived the Rotary motto "Service above Self" over his 40+ years' service.

Des was also a member of the Action Outdoors Association from 2000 to 2016, undertaking the President role in 2003, and very active in various other roles during his 13 years up to his passing in 2016.



As a reflection of Des's commitment to the Rotary ideals and objectives, and the near 30 year membership at the Rotary Club of Como, Des generously provided for a bequest to the Como Rotary Club in his Will, for the establishment of a Foundation, with funds to be used to support worthy causes in the local community over a number of years.

Due to the strong Community Partnership relationship over many years between the Como Rotary Club and Como Secondary College, the Club has approved to use part of the Foundation funds for the establishment of a \$5,000 5 year Student Scholarship, with an annual donation of \$1,000, commencing in February 2021.
